WHAT ARE MICROFACIAL EXPRESSIONS?

Expressions in the face, showing the presence of emotions.

Extremely „short-lasting“ – between 1/15 and 1/25 of a second.

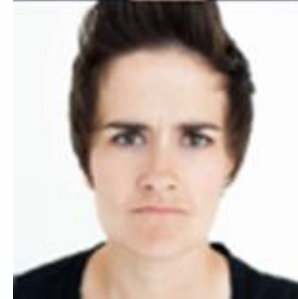
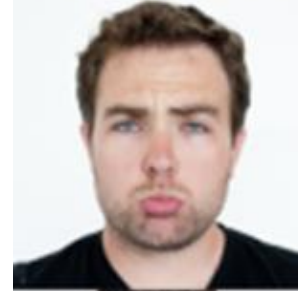
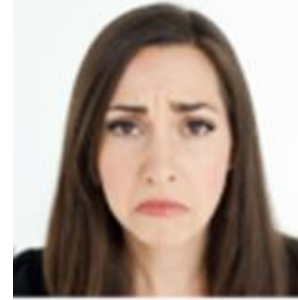
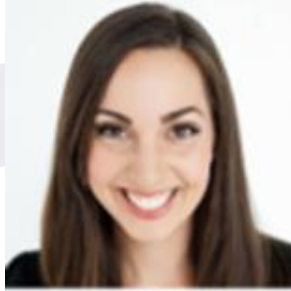
Typically appearing when we are feeling these emotions, but we don't want to show it, i.e. trying to disguise an emotion.

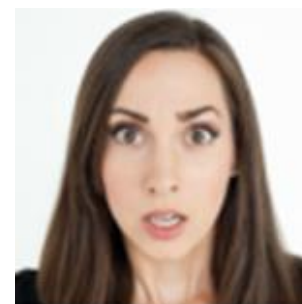
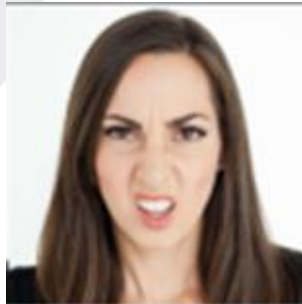
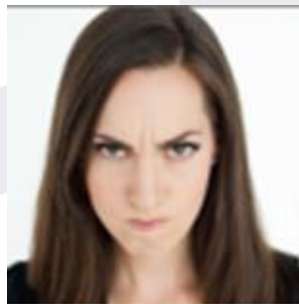
